

On August 15, 2003, petitioner filed a petition to the Oregon Supreme Court to review HB 2003, identified as the PERS Reform and Stabilization Act of 2003. The Act provided an opportunity to a person who is or will be adversely affected by the Act to file a petition with the Oregon Supreme Court to review provisions of the 2003 Act that violate any constitutional provision. The Act did not require a petition to be filed stating a controversy.

Subsequently, the Act was amended by HB 3020. Petitioner would not have filed a petition with the Oregon Supreme Court asking the court to review the amended law.

Petitioner moves to dismiss the petition without costs, as there are no adverse parties to this petition at the time of this filing.




