34	Requires balancing timber production, resource conservation/preservation in managing state forests; specifically addresses two forests.	Yes: 38% No: 62%
37	Governments must pay owners, or forgo enforcement, when certain land use restrictions reduce property value.	Yes: 61% No: 39%
38*	Abolishes SAIF; State must reinsure, satisfy SAIF's obligations; dedicates proceeds, potential surplus to public purposes.	Yes: 39% No: 61%

Measure	Ballot Title or Description	Election Results
33	Amends medical marijuana act: requires marijuana dispensaries for supplying patient/caregivers; raises patients' possession limit.	Yes: 43% No: 57%
35*	Limits noneconomic damages (defined) recoverable for patient injuries cause by healthcare provider's negligence or recklessness.	Yes: 49% No: 51%
36*	Only marriage between one man and one woman is valid or legally recognized as marriage.	Yes: 57% No: 43%

31*	Authorizes law permitting postponement of election for particular public office when nominee for office dies.	Yes: 66% No: 34%
32*	Deletes reference to mobile homes from provision dealing wiht taxes and fees on motor vehicles.	Yes: 61% No: 39%
